NRA JUNIOR SMALLBORE INTERMEDIATE RIFLE CAMP July 05-10, 2017 CAMP PERRY, OHIO

March 6, 2017

Attention All Junior Smallbore Rifle Shooters!

The NRA is pleased to announce that its annual **NRA Junior Smallbore Rifle Camp** will be held on **Wednesday July 05 through Monday July 10, 2017, at Petrarca Range, Camp Perry, Ohio.**

CAMP PROGRAM AND OBJECTIVES:

All smallbore & air rifle camp students will receive expert coaching in the fundamental principles and techniques of **3-position** and **4-position** smallbore and **International air rifle** shooting. Students will be provided a safe, enjoyable learning experience that will significantly contribute to improving their shooting skills.

STUDENT ELIGIBILITY:

The smallbore rifle camp has been primarily designed for the intermediate shooter, and will be held using both smallbore and air rifles. **Students must supply their own smallbore rifle.** Students are encouraged to bring their own air rifle – but the CMP will lend sporter air rifles to campers who do not have one to bring.

All applicants are encouraged to apply as soon as possible.

Camp is designed for junior shooters age 12 - 20 who have fired in a competition, such as NRA Junior 3P or 4P Smallbore Sectional competition, 3P Precision Air Sectional, USA 3P JORC. To assist us with your learning experience list location and type of match, date and score fired. (attach a highlighted results copy). Admission is open 01 March through 30 April or until camp is filled (based on postmark). All junior shooting competitors are welcome.

ADULT SPONSORSHIP:

Students who have not reached their **18th Birthday** by July 5, 2017, must be accompanied to Camp Perry by an adult sponsor (age 21 or older). An adult may not sponsor more than **three** junior students.

LIMITED ENROLLMENT: Enrollment will be limited to 70 students.

REGISTRATION AND FEES:

Registration forms and fees for camp will be accepted at NRA Headquarters on a first-come, first-served basis. For all mailed entries, the earliest postmarks will be used to determine order of acceptance. Registration fees cover all administrative costs and training materials. (The registration fees do not cover costs such as travel and room and board.)

- Advanced Registration: The fee for advanced registration is \$230.00 per student, and must be received with registration forms by the NRA not later than June 01, 2017.
- Standard Registration: The fee for standard registration is \$250.00 per student.
 This fee will be charged for students whose registration materials are received after June 01, 2017 (postmarks will determine acceptance of all mailed materials), or for students who register directly at Camp Perry.
- In the case of cancellation by the camper, refunds will be issued less a 20% administrative fee.

All required entry forms for the Smallbore Rifle Camp are enclosed with this letter, and consist of:

- Registration Form (should include NRA Jr. Sectional scores or any match score)
- Health History Form (this form must be notarized)
- Special Power of Attorney Form (for campers with sponsor other than parent (this form <u>must</u> be notarized - and retained by/with the campers sponsor so they may care for the camper.
- Required and Optional Equipment Form
- Lodging Information

Students should review all entry forms with their parents prior to submission.

The NRA will acknowledge all student entries in writing, and Camp Perry Reporting information will be sent to each student with the acknowledgement letter.

OTHER COSTS:

Students are required to cover the cost of their room and board, plus all other incidental and personal expenses.

Cost of lodging in Camp Perry huts will be \$43.90 per night for the hut. Hut lodging arrangements must be handled directly with the Camp Perry Clubhouse Rental Office (See the enclosed *Lodging Information* materials for details).

CANCELLATION OF CAMP:

The NRA reserves the right to cancel the smallbore rifle camp if a minimum of 50 students have not registered by June 01, 2017. Cancellation notifications will be mailed and emailed to each registrant if the camp is canceled.

STAFF QUALIFICATIONS:

All instruction and coaching will be conducted by outstanding official **NRA Certified Coaches, including members of the NRA National Coach Development Staff.**

PASS THE WORD

Let your friends and other junior smallbore rifle shooters you may know about this camp. Please feel free to forward copies of all the enclosed materials, and give them to other persons who might wish to attend this smallbore rifle camp.

Camp Activities for 2017 will be divided between 50 & 100 yd. smallbore rifle shooting on Petrarca Range, Camp Perry, and 10 meter Air Rifle shooting on the CMP Gary Anderson Air Rifle Range, Camp Perry. All campers will spend time at both ranges and will practice and compete in both smallbore and air rifle. Camp direction is to give shooters the boost required to improve scores that may lead to collegiate shooting. Both Smallbore & International Standing Air Rifle are priorities but all campers will attempt some 3P air practice or matches as well.

JOIN US THIS YEAR

We at NRA hope that you will be able to join us this year for what we know will be an enjoyable and memorable learning experience. Have fun, make new friends, and improve your shooting skills. It's a great way to spend a few days this summer!

How To Register For Camp

- -Fill out and return registration form. This form should be filled out electronically and returned via email to coaching@nrahq.org. This will pre-register you for the camp. Once all other require items are received, you will be officially enrolled in camp. This is form 2017CampApplication_Registration.pdf
- -Send in a copy of your sectional or match scores and a copy of your NRA classification card if you have one. These should also be submitted electronically to coaching@nrahq.org

-Send payment for the camp via check or money order to

Make payable to NRA for \$230.00 (\$250 after June 1, 2017) Payment must be received within 2 week of submitting your application. If not received within two weeks, we may open the slot up to persons on the waitlist.

- -Health History form must be submitted ASAP. This should also be submitted electronically. Once notarized, scan the document into a PDF file and send to coaching@nrahq.org THIS FORM MUST BE NOTERIZED. This is form 2017CampApplication_healthHistory.pdf
- Your Registration Materials include a "Special Power of Attorney Form" that must be retained and sent with your camper's Sponsor so they will be able to provide Health Care Assistance for your camper Traveling to / from and @ National Matches Junior Smallbore Camp. DO NOT SEND THIS FORM TO US. The original is to be possessed by the sponsor. This is form 2017CampApplication PowerofAttorney.pdf
- -Alternately, all required forms can be printed, filled out and mailed to the address above. However, registration is on a first-come, first-served basis. Mailing in the registration page will take longer than submitting electronically.

REQUIRED ITEMS

(Most, if not all, equipment items can be purchased from vendors on Commercial Row at Camp Perry.)

- 1. .22 Caliber Smallbore Target Rifle with Metallic Aperture Sights
- 2. .17 Caliber Air Rifle Sporter or Precision (CMP has sporter air rifles available for loan @ the CMP Range.)
- 3. Hearing Protection ~ Ear Plugs and/or Ear Muffs
- 4. Eye Protection Shooting Glasses, Safety Glasses or Prescription Safety Glasses
- 5. Ground Cloth Shooting Mat, 3' wide by 5' long (approximately) Heavy Carpet, or Heavy Blanket
- 6. Sling with Sling Swivel **on** Rifle
- 7. Shooting Glove or Shooting Mitt
- 8. Shooting Jacket -- Cloth w/ Leather/Rubber Shoulder/Elbow Pads or NRA Leather or International Style
- 9. Sweat Shirts (2) Medium to Heavy Thickness, Non-hooded recommended, Zipper Front is OK
- 10. Spotting Scope with Stand for use in Prone to Standing Positions (Recommend 20X min.; Higher Power or Variable Power Optional)
- 11. Kneeling Roll
- 12. Loading Block
- 13. 16 Target Clips (binder clip No. 100 Large) BLACK or SILVER ONLY! NO Colors! Rule18.15 (f)
- 14. Standing Position Rifle Stand; Beginners can fabricate using medium to heavy duty camera tripod and soft covered wooden block attached at camera position, 3"X4"X1".
- 15. Cleaning Rod Guide
- 16. Cleaning Rod, Single piece, plastic coated recommended, with JAG.
- 17. 2-3 Bore-Brushes, .22 Cal. Rifle (other than for pistol)
- 18. Bore Cleaning Solvent, 4-6 ounce bottle (If glass bottle, should be wrapped with several layers of Masking Tape to help prevent breakage.)
- 19. 50-100 Bore Cleaning Patches
- 20. Tooth Brush for Rifle Cleaning
- Q-Tips for Rifle Cleaning
- 22. Ammunition:1000 rounds of standard velocity target ammunition (CAMP WILL NOT HAVE ANY 22 Caliber AMMO)
- 23. <u>Yellow</u> Open Bolt Indicator available at camp for \$1.00
- 24. .177 caliber Alr Rifle pellets to suit your Air Rifle (1,000) (CMP will have basic 177 pellets available if required)

OPTIONAL ITEMS

- 1. Shooting Trousers
- 2. Shooting Boots
- 3. Wind Gauge
- 4. Rain Gear Rain Suit and 6' X 8' Light Weight Waterproof Material for use to cover shooting equipment. Poncho not recommended for use while shooting.
- 5. Stopwatch or Electronic Timer. A timer that will permit the count-down of hours and minutes is recommended.

<u>Acceptable Rifles</u> - The camp will accept any .22 caliber target type rifle that meets Rule 3.2 of the current NRA Smallbore Rifle Rules. Any Air Rifle that meets Rule 3.6 of current NRA International Rifle Rules. Any Air Rifle that meets National Standard Three-Position Air Rifles Rules 4.2 Sporter Air Rifle or 4.4 Precision Air Rifle.

NRA Smallbore Rifle Rule 3.2 ~ A rifle authorized for use in Smallbore Rifle Matches using cartridges commercially catalogued as the .22 Short, .22 Long or .22 Long Rifle cartridges. There are no restrictions on the barrel length or overall weight of the rifle and accessories. Any safe trigger is allowed. No portion of the rifle or any attachment to the rifle shall extend more than 3 inches beyond the rear of the shooter's shoulder. A butt plate conforming with NRA Rule 3.15 may be used. Around the body, or around the shoulder hooks are not permitted. The same rifle must be used throughout all stages of any one match (except aggregate) except in the case of a malfunction or disabled rifle when the competitor may change rifles with permission of the Chief Range Officer. In NRA Metric Position Course shooting, this rule will govern the conduct of the match and may not be waived by the Match Sponsor.

SMALLBORE RIFLE CAMP LODGING INFORMATION

Available Lodging Types -

Huts: 4 single beds, \$43.90 plus tax per night.

Other lodging types may be available at Camp Perry, such as open bay barracks, modular housing, and/or cottages. Current rates apply.

Reservations for hutments or barracks may be made beginning on April 21nd through the 25th, 2017 by telephoning the Camp Perry Housing Office toll free number–1-888-889-7010. Be sure to get a confirmation number. Housing is assigned on a first-come, first-served basis. A deposit is required. Housing fees are to be paid on arrival at Camp Perry. Housing information is also available at *http://www.cplcc.com*

No written requests will be accepted for lodging.

When calling to book your lodging:

- Know your arrival and departure dates.
- Names and addresses of your roommates, if any.
- Credit card (MC, VISA, or American Express), a non-refundable deposit will be required when making your reservation. The deposit fee will be processed and be charged to your credit card account <u>at the time of your call.</u> (Deposit payment is equal to the first night's rent on each rental unit reserved, and is a non-refundable payment.) Deposit payment may not be moved to cover the cost of other beds. Each confirmed room's first night's rent is based on the deposit applied to that room only, if the room is canceled at any time, this deposit is forfeited.
- You will be given a confirmation number at the time of your call. No confirmation letter will be sent.
 Please keep this number somewhere safe. You will need to have this number to make changes and at check-in.
- Check-in time for all reservations is from 2:00 p.m. until 10:00 p.m. on your arrival date. Reservations, which are not picked up by 10:00 p.m. on the arrival date, will be considered canceled, unless arrangements have been made with the Camp Perry Clubhouse Rental Office prior to the 10:00 p.m. cut off. Checkout must be accomplished no later than 10:00 a.m. on your departure day. Additional charges will be incurred for late check-outs and no show/failure to cancel reservations.
- Requestor must be 18 years of age or older to request reservations. Proof of age may be requested upon check-in.
